CALIFORNIA CHAMPAGNE

Natural Kobel 2013 Russian River

Sweepstakes, 2017 S.F. Chronical

Very dry, delicate California champagne made from the finest Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes grown in the cool climate of the Russian River Valley in Sonoma County. It features apple notes complemented by sweet flavors of orange, lime and raspberry.



WHITE WINE

Pinot Gris La Crema 2015 Monterey County

87 Points, WineEthusiast

Nectarine, Bosc pear, honeysuckle and wet river stone aromas. Melon, yellow apple and Meyer lemon flavors. Lively acidity with a lengthy, but refined finish.



Sauvignon Blanc *St. Anne's Crossing* 2015 Ritchie Reserve Russian River Valley Double Gold, 2017 S.F. Chronical

Honeydew, passionfruit, and peach aromas introduce a crisp and cool palate packed with flavors of grapefruit, pear, and guava.



RED WINE

Pinot Noir St. Francis Winery 2015 Sonoma County

Best of Class and Double Gold, 2016 Sonoma County Harvest Fair

Bright and focused, this medium-bodied Pinot Noir offers aromas of red fruit with notes of nutmeg and clove. Flavors of cranberry, pomegranate and fresh raspberry entice before a long, juicy finish.



Zinfandel Laurel Hill (Mayo Family Winery) 2013 Old Vine, Russian River Valley

Gold Metal, 2016 Sonoma County Harvest Fair

It is a big, rich, abundant Zin that is fleshy and decadent with dark fruit. It has a peppery finish, and reminds us of blackberry cobbler.



SyrahAlexander Valley Vineyards 2014 Estate, Alexander Valley 91 pt, California State Fair, 91pt, WineEnthusiast, more...

This lush wine has aromas of violets, red fruit, juicy cherry, blackberry and vanilla. There are rich flavors of blackberry jam, black cherry, plum and vanilla with silky tannins and a long juicy finish.



Cabernet Sauvignon Pezzi King 2012 Estate Reserve, Dry Creek Gold Medal, 2016 Sonoma County Harvest Fair

Elegant aromatics of blackberry, chocolate covered espresso bean and acai berry swirl around a palate abundant with flavors of dark chocolate, brandied cherry and soft leather. The savory finish lingers slowly with flavors of spicy marionberry, cedar and black currant. This full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon has supple tannins, making it an ideal pairing for juicy ribeye with a red wine sauce.
